Recycle used motor oil & filters

Used motor oil is one of the most prevalent pollutants found in creeks, lakes, and rivers!

Follow these simple steps -

- * Drain your used motor oil into a clean, sealed container. An old milk jug will do fine!
- * Never mix used motor oil with trash, antifreeze, degreasers, brake fluids, or other automotive chemicals. Also, don't mix used motor oil with cooking oils, paint thinners, gasoline or other fluids or solvents.
- * Recycle your used motor oil and filters by taking them to an approved collection site for used motor oil.
