BMP 101: Storm Water Management During Construction Training Class

This one day class is designed for individuals working in or with the construction industry that are required to manage or regulate storm water during construction activities.

This class offers students the opportunity to learn about Montana DEQ's storm water program and permitting requirements including storm water pollution prevention plans, learn about erosion and sedimentation, types of Best Management Practices to control erosion and sedimentation, how to select and install appropriate Best Management Practices, and good housekeeping measures to control pollutant sources other than sediment.

The course will address topics that will prepare students for proper selection, application, and maintenance requirements of Best Management Practices. Information provided will include a training manual and a DEQ BMP Field Guide.

The class is hosted by **City of Kalispell** with the training being provided by a **DEQ** compliance inspector and an instructor from **Altitude Training Associates**.

Goals of the Class

- Learn about the City of Kalispell's MS4 permitting program
- **Learn MT DEQ's storm water program and legal requirements including permitting and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans**
- Learn the difference between erosion and sedimentation
- **Learn the different types of Best Management Practices for specific applications to control erosion and sedimentation**
- Learn how to properly install and maintain Best Management Practices for controlling erosion and sedimentation
- **Learn Good Housekeeping Measures**
