Yard Maintenance and Our Waterways

Anything that enters a storm drain goes directly to local streams and lakes including:

- ⇒ Lawn fertilizer
- ⇒ Grass Clippings
- ⇒ Pet Waste
- ⇒ Tree Leaves

Listed below are best management practices that you can implement to help improve the water quality of our local streams and lakes:

- ⇒ Use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly and in the recommended amounts.
- ⇒ Avoid pesticide and fertilizer application if the forecast calls for rain; otherwise chemicals will be washed into the storm drain system.
- ⇒ Don't over water your lawn.
- ⇒ Rake grass clippings out of the street and gutter. Compost on site, bag for collection, or take to the community compost program.
- ⇒ Sweep up grass clippings, soil, and fertilizers from driveways, sidewalks, and streets.
