

Core, rail redevelopment begins in Kalispell

KALISPELL, Mont. -

The city of Kalispell is moving forward on a major redevelopment of the downtown core. The project is called the Kalispell Core and Rail Redevelopment.

A [project website](#) claims the Core and Rail Redevelopment opens doors for Kalispell residents to once again enjoy entertainment, green space, increased walkability and safety in Kalispell's Core Area. It encourages a larger retail presence at the heart of the community.

Existing business affected by the removal of train tracks through the city center would be encouraged to relocate to a new rail park on the Kalispell's east side.

According to the project timeline, construction of the rail park starts this year.

Cenex Harvest States will relocate to the rail park in 2018. Tracks will be removed from the city center in 2019.

The redevelopment includes 365 acres in Kalispell's downtown and 43 acres of commercial space in the new rail park.
