The City of Kalispell is calling for community action this March. We're proposing a dedicated emergency responder levy in a special mail-in election, aiming to significantly improve our emergency response capabilities. **Recent reports reveal a rise in emergency calls and response times that exceed national benchmarks.** This levy is our response to these growing demands as we seek to enhance our police, fire, and ambulance services with additional officers and firefighter/paramedics.



**\$82.22 in annual taxes per \$100,000 of assessed home valuation allows for:**

**2 DETECTIVES + 1 CRIME ANALYST**

to address rising case load and criminal trends

**ADDITIONAL STAFFED FIRE ENGINES**

(also available to respond to Ambulance calls)  
available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

**1-2 ADDITIONAL OFFICERS**

on the street per shift to reduce response times and increase proactive policing efforts

**ADDITIONAL STAFFED AMBULANCE**

available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

**ADDITIONAL STAFFED FIRE STATION**

in western Kalispell to reduce call response times
